Cyber Security

Rules 1, 2 & 3 - NEVER

1. Call the number that just appeared on your screen.
2. Talk to anyone who calls you and claims they know you have a computer or a device, just hang up.
3. Give out any personal information or credit card details to an unsolicited caller.

Cyber Security - What you should do.

ALWAYS

1. Stay calm and IGNORE all and any instructions
2. Turn off your speakers
3. On a PC, “End Tasks” On a mac “Force Quit” On a tablet or phone close all apps.
4. Use a good antivirus/anti-malware (I recommend Malwarebytes)

Computer Calendars

It is important to use “Cloud Based” calendars.
Why?

1. They synchronize across all your devices
2. You can share them with partners and loved ones
3. Appointments can be automatically entered from an email
4. Reminders can alert you on multiple devices

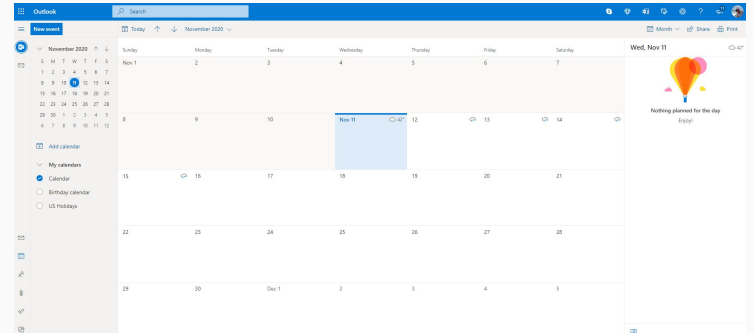
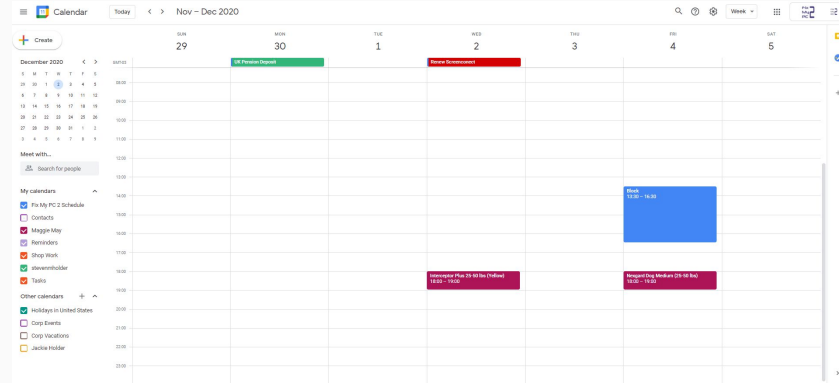

If you have a GMail, or outlook.com (hotmail, msn etc) You already have a Cloud based calendar.

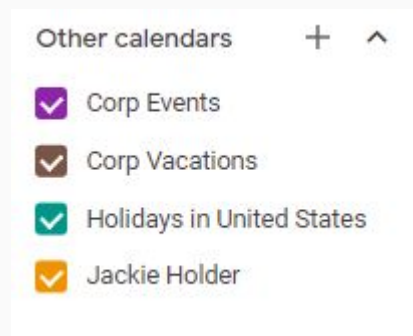
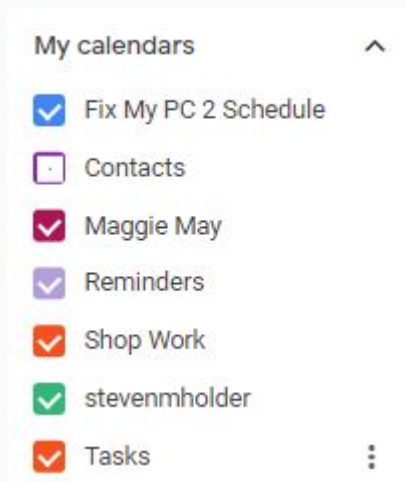
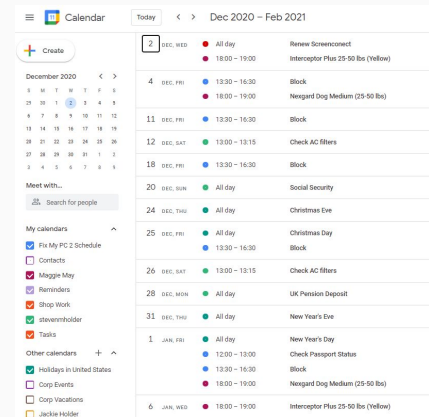
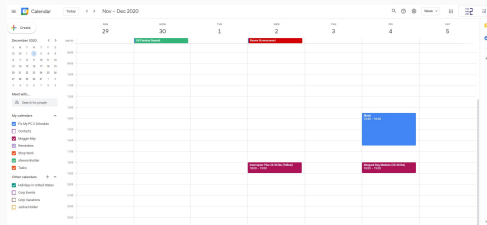


Computer Calendars

Switching Email Providers - Who?

1. Don't use your Internet provider
 - a. They typically provide slow and unreliable service or farm it out to AOL :)
2. Pick a provider you are comfortable with and feel are in it for the long haul
3. Choose a free service, who knows if a paid service will raise their rates or simply go out of business
4. Make sure they have the ability to get your old email until all your contacts are aware of your new address

Switching Email Providers - Who?

I prefer GMail (Google mail)

Outlook.com is another good option.

Switching Email Providers - How?

- Create your new GMail or Hotmail address
- Go into settings for that new account and tell the provider to go get your old email from now on.
- Create a signature that tells the recipients that you are switching to a new provider

PC/Mac/Chrome - Computers Desktops and laptops

1. Windows
2. Mac OS
3. Chrome OS

Smartphones and Tablets

1. IOS (Apple iPhone and iPads)
2. Android OS (Other Google based smart phones, Samsung, LG, etc.)

PC vs Tablets

PC Pro's & Cons

PROS

1. Full size screen mouse and keyboard
2. Been around a long time and can run almost all software
3. Stable products from Apple and Microsoft (Operating systems)
4. Upgradeable

CONS

1. High cost of ownership
 - a. Software
 - b. Maintenance
 - c. Support
2. Fragile (Laptops especially)
3. Can easily get viruses
4. Software does not always work especially after an upgrade.

PC vs Tablets

Tablets Pro's & Cons

PROS

1. They are light and portable
2. They are easy to use just like your smartphone
3. Most Apps are FREE or just a couple of bucks
4. Don't get viruses that easily
5. Software upgrades don't usually kill the device
6. Low cost of ownership

CONS

1. Not repairable
2. Fragile if dropped
3. Not much local storage (it's all in the cloud)
4. Not that easy to type on unless you add an external keyboard
